NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This championship will be governed by:
- 1.2. The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025–2028.
- 1.3. The J24 Class Rules in force as of March 2026.
- 1.4. The FAY Competition Organization Regulations apply.
- 1.5. Racing rules and Race Signals 25, 33, 35, 62.1, A4, A5, and the preamble to Part 4 of the RRS are modified as described in the corresponding instructions.
- 1.6. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. This modifies rule 63.5(c).

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20 and the Class Rules.
- 2.2. In accordance with WS Regulation 20.4, and if required and supplied by the Organizing Authority, boats shall permanently display bow decals and/or sponsor flags on the forestay while at the club.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The championship is open to all J24 class boats holding a valid measurement certificate (copy onboard together with the mandatory and optional equipment checklist) and with the 2026 J24 CLASS annual fee paid up to date.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at the following [LINK](#), starting May 1, 2026, and no later than 20:00 on August 7, 2026.



3.3. Fees:

3.3.1. A payment of US\$ 550. If payment is made in Argentine pesos, the seller exchange rate quoted by Banco de la Nación Argentina on the day of the transfer shall apply. Once the bank transfer has been completed, proof of payment must be emailed to secretaria@clubnauticocordoba.com.ar with the subject "Sudamericano J24 entry payment for boat..."

3.3.2. Boats paying the entry fee before June 20, 2025, will receive a discount, paying US\$ 400.

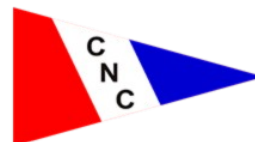
4. SCHEDULE

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- 4.1. Twelve (12) races are scheduled. The reserve day will be used if five valid races have not been completed by the end of racing on Sunday the 16th.
- 4.2. No more than four (4) races per day will be sailed.
- 4.3. On the last day of the championship, Sunday the 16th, no warning signal will be made after 17:00. The same will apply if the reserve day is used.
- 4.4. If the reserve day is used, the Organizing Authority will attempt to run as many races as possible, up to a maximum of 4.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the Virtual Official Notice Board and on the event website starting June 20, 2026, at 10:00.

6. COURSE

- 6.1. The course to be used will be a 4-leg WINDWARD-LEEWARD course.
- 6.2. Marks shall be left to port.
- 6.3. A windward offset mark will be used, and after the windward mark there will be an offset or wing mark that shall be left to port.
- 6.4. The leeward mark will be a gate. If for any reason one of the gate marks is missing, the remaining mark shall be left to port.

7. HEARING REQUESTS

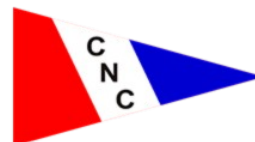
- 7.1. On the last day of racing, a boat may not protest regarding measurement matters. This modifies RRS 60.

8. VALIDITY AND SCORING

- 8.1. This championship will be valid if at least five races are completed.
- 8.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score if six or more races are completed.



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9. PRIZES

- 9.1. Prizes will be awarded for first through third place.
- 9.2. The South American Champion title will be awarded to the highest-ranked boat whose crew has at least 60% of its members holding nationality from one of the countries in the Region.
- 9.3. A prize will be awarded to the highest-ranked boat with an all-female crew.

10. BOAT PARK

- 10.1. The boat park will be located at the Club Náutico Córdoba mooring area.
- 10.2. Boats must remain in the boat park from 11:00 on Thursday, August 13, until the completion of the final race of the championship, except when racing or sailing to or from the racing area.
- 10.3. Hull cleaning in the boat park is permitted only with biodegradable products and without the use of oxygen equipment.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

The organizers and the Commissions representing the Institution, regardless of their purpose, organize, promote, and oversee these regattas with the understanding that neither the Institutions and/or their representatives, Commission members, or their staff assume any direct or indirect responsibility for damages, loss, injuries, and/or any type of inconvenience arising from participation in these sporting events or in the preparation prior to them, whether involving persons and/or items found aboard a participating boat, sailing and/or moored before and/or after the start and finish, regardless of whether these were caused by negligence or intentional acts of third parties, connected or not to the institutions.

Consequently, the Organizing Club shall not be responsible for the disappearance of property, whether part of the boats' equipment or belonging personally to crew members or to third parties connected in a sporting, commercial, or social capacity with the participants. Likewise, in this regard, all competitors and yacht owners participating or intending to participate shall be deemed to undertake the commitment to hold the Club, the Race



Committee, its employees, and representatives harmless from liability during the regattas and related activities. The decision to start or continue racing shall be considered the responsibility of the participants, in accordance with Rule 3.
